### STATE ROAD 7 PROJECT FROM SR 704/OKEECHOBEE BOULEVARD TO NORTHLAKE BOULEVARD

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will conduct a Virtual Public Workshop regarding the improvements for SR 7 in Palm Beach County. This Virtual Public Workshop will have representatives available to answer questions. Project information is posted at [www.sr7extension.com](http://www.sr7extension.com). Questions and comments may be submitted prior to the meeting through the registration link, website or by emailing the project manager. Questions and comments may also be submitted through the chat window during the workshop.

### PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Adding two new travel lanes between Okeechobee Blvd and 60th Street to provide two lanes in each direction.
- Reconstructing the 60th Street roundabout from a one-lane to a two-lane roundabout.
- Constructing a four-lane divided roadway on a new alignment from 60th Street to Northlake Blvd.
- Constructing crossings over the M-Canal and the Ibis Preserve spillway.
- Constructing a 12' shared-use path from 60th Street to Northlake Blvd.

### CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

- Work will be conducted in phases to minimize construction impacts.
- Short-term, temporary detours are anticipated for construction of connections to Orange Grove Blvd. and Persimmon Blvd. Both one-mile long detours will occur along 110th Avenue North, and both will be limited to one weekend each, and will not occur at the same time.
- Business and resident access will be maintained throughout construction.

- Construction Begins: Winter/Spring 2022
- Anticipated Completion: Fall/Winter 2024
- Construction Cost Estimate: \$69 million
